Children's Cemetery bench

A resident has approached Councillors regarding CCBC policy which does not allow installation of memorial benches in a CCBC cemetery. It is suggested that an additional bench is provided by BTMCC for crematorium area, as well at Children's area. Total price for 2 benches at a cost of £1560 plus £108 delivery. £800 approx quoted already for Children's cemetery and agreed.

RESOLVED: To request additional cost of bench agreed at Full council

9. Wildflower Verges

These have now been planted and invoice received for £250 from CCBC

10. Riverside Walk

Councillors and Clerk has made several site visits in conjunction with various CCBC departments and Countryside warden, etc. Longer and shorter terms plans outlined include new parking (disabled a priority), pathways, seating, signage and picnic benches. Initial stage is 2 x Oak picnic benches - £750 each, so £1500 total. Countryside warden replacing metal Benches £350 — renew 2 to wood if poss. @ £350 each. Block stone to stop inappropriate parking £300 . JCB to install - £250. Countryside warden will arrange and cover installation.

Total cost: no more than £3000
