Garden maintenance — Cllr Bull updated maintenance needs of community Garden. Committee recommends progress to be made with Pergola construction funded by CIL. Also agreed was the purchase of petrol trimmer £400, purchase of checker plates £300. The committee is recommending the costs are drawn from the maintenance budget.
